Duties:

- Sell admission tickets at Independence Seaport Museum's front desk, ships' ticket booth and boat rental booth
- Promote and sell memberships
- Provide tourism information beyond the Museum to visitors
- Service inbound calls and inquiries in a professional manner
- Occasionally assist in Museum gift shop to relieve for breaks and days off
- Monitor assigned museum galleries and spaces
- Receive deliveries and mail
- Act as host to birthday party groups and provide activities
- Learn and teach educational programs for children grades K-8, as assigned
- Provide overnight/slumber and scout programming support
- Provide summer camp programming support, including on-water activities
- Provide guided historic ships tours to visitors or groups, as assigned
