You must take your Independence Seaport Museum membership card with you in order to verify your identity and the active status of your membership. We are unable to verify Independence Seaport Museum membership via telephone. Without your card, you will be required to pay full admission prices.

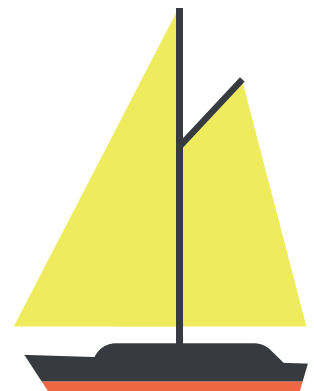
